Derry Borough Council met in special session Monday, March 24, 2014, at 7:00P.M. at the Derry Municipal Building 114 E. 2nd Avenue, Derry PA with the following members present: Joseph Morton, Presiding, Chad Fabian, Al Checca, Kristine Melville, and Allen Skopp. Jim Ritenour and Nelie Smith were absent. Mayor Dave Bolen was present. Solicitor Lee Demosky was not present. Nick Cammuso, Latrobe Bulletin and Greg Reinbold, Tribune Review was reporting.

SPECIAL BUSINESS

1. One bid was received for the purchase of millings stored at the Derry Township facility from Tresco Paving in the amount of \$2,835.00. **MOTION** by Allen Skopp to accept bid from Tresco Paving Corporation for the Millings for Sale at the bid price of \$2,835.00. Motion **SECONDED** by Chad Fabian. All members present voiced “aye” in favor of the motion. Motion passed.
2. **MOTION** by Allen Skopp to hire Jessie Patterson as the Pool Manager for 2014 Outdoor Community Pool Season. Motion **SECONDED** by Chad Fabian. Kristine Melville abstained from voting. Four members of council voiced “aye” in favor of the motion. Motion passed.

Mayor Dave Bolen is concerned that the pool pass pricing discussed at the last meeting was a little high, asking council to revisit pricing.

Al Checca was hoping lowering the pool pass prices would allow more families to purchase passes, and in turn would increase concession sales for the season.

Allen Skopp mentioned that the increase is small for a four year comparison and we need to look at the pool as a business to maintain operational costs.

Kristine Melville mentioned offering low income family discount, and the program can be run through the school district.

Mr. Skopp explained that these programs are offered through other agencies.

Ms. Melville thought that the information should be available if needed for individuals requesting assistance. She did say the information should be at the pool office area from last year.

It was discussed, that new manager will have time to review prior to the opening pool season and develop a process for inquiries.

The president requested council to review again at the next work session in April and confirm pricing for the pool at that time.
